

## **Practical Nursing Program – Costs and Financial Aid**

### ***Program Costs (Estimated)***

- Pre-Clinical Books: \$600.
- Pre-Entrance Test (TEAS): \$80.
- Uniform, Lab Coat, and Shoes: \$250 – \$300 (varies with type and number of uniforms).
- Books and Supplies: \$1,000.
- Nursing Assessments: \$400 – \$450 per semester (\$1,200 – \$1,350 total).
- Graduation Pin: \$50.
- Medical Exam and Immunizations: Varies (sample estimate \$250).
- Criminal Background Check and Drug Screen: \$90..
- CPR Certification: \$75.
- Campus Lab and Clinical Supplies: \$250.
- NCLEX-PN Exam and PN License Fees: ~\$400.

### ***Total Estimate in Addition to Tuition/Fees***

Approximately \$4,505 (using \$250 as sample Medical Exam fee).
