

Weekend Program Option ADN for January 2027

The Weekend program option for ADN is open to all students who meet the same admission criteria as the traditional program. Complete developmental requirements for English (EDE 10 or 11), Math (MDE 10) and NAS 2 (pre-req for BIO 141) as determined by SVCC admissions.

This option begins in January 2027 Spring semester and ends four semesters later in Spring, May 2028. Students will need to make careful arrangements for work and other responsibilities to devote the appropriate attention to learning complex material.

Admission to the program is not guaranteed.

Classes are typically held Saturday/Sunday and clinical on Friday/Sunday

All potential students must:

- apply during the application period (September 14, 2025 - October 30, 2026 for the January 2026 program)
- complete the [mandatory information session](#) prior to application found on the ADN website.
- submit all official college transcripts to Admissions and Records (admissions@southside.edu)
- Complete the TEAS test - register at [TEAS Test at ATI Testing](#) and place in the $\geq 65\%$ overall on the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) entrance test.
- have a curricular GPA of 2.5 in the five pre-requisite classes SDV 100, ENG 111, PSY 230, ITE 152, BIO 141. It is recommended to complete as many co-requisite classes as possible prior to starting in the clinical program. They include BIO 142, BIO 150, ENG 112 and HUM 200 elective.

The TEAS test must be successfully completed prior to applying.

There will be Fall TEAS dates for SVCC posted at southside.edu/teas in August 2026.

Applications are due October 30, 2026, for the January 2027 RN Weekend program.
