

General Education Requirements – ADN/RN

The following pre-requisites must be completed prior to or currently enrolled in the courses during the Spring semester when applying to the ADN/RN Clinical Nursing Program:

- SDV 100 College Success Skills - 1 credit (VCCS Policy: Must be completed within first 15 credits)
- ENG 111 College Composition 1 - 3 credits
- BIO 141 (or 231) Human Anatomy and Physiology I - 4 credits (Must be completed within 10 years of beginning the RN program.)
 - Effective **Summer 2023** - NAS 2 is a pre-req for BIO 141 if not previously taken. Students who have completed BIO 101 with a C or better do not have to take NAS 2. Students may test out of NAS 2.
- PSY 230 - Developmental Psychology - 3 credits
- ITE 152 - Intro to Dig Inf Lit & Comp Ap (or ITE 119 - Information Literacy within 5 years) - 3 credits

Other required general education courses:

Though the following required courses may be taken as listed within the [Nursing Curriculum](#) and are therefore not prerequisites for admission to the Nursing program, students are strongly encouraged to complete these courses prior to beginning the clinical Nursing Courses:

- BIO 142 Human Anatomy and Physiology II – 4 credits (or BIO 232); BIO 141/142 must be completed within 10 years of beginning the RN program.)
- BIO 150 Microbiology - 4 credits (May be taken prior to or in summer between first and second clinical years)
- ENG 112 College Composition 2 - 3 credits
- HUM 200-level elective (humanities, philosophy, religion, 200 level English. Course number must be 200 or greater) - 3 credits
