

ADN Program – Costs and Financial Aid

(May 2025 Update)

Tuition

College tuition and fees for the 67 required credits: \$171.80 per credit hour x 67 credits = \$11,510.60.

Final tuition rate for the 2025–2026 Academic Year will be updated at the Tuition and Fees page.

Additional Program Costs (Estimated)

- Books – Pre-Clinical Phase: \$700 – \$900.
- ATI-TEAS Pre-Entrance Test Fee: \$90.
- CPR Certification: \$60 – \$80.
- Uniforms and Shoes: \$250 – \$350.
- Books – First Clinical Year: \$1,000 (e-books).
- Books – Second Clinical Year: \$700.
- Assessment Testing (per clinical semester): \$500 (\$2,000 total over 2 years).
- Medical Exam and Immunizations: \$300 (varies).
- Campus Laboratory Kit: \$200 – \$250.
- Criminal Background Check, Urine Drug Screen (Castlebranch): \$90
- Clinical Site Fees: \$50 –\$100 per semester
- Graduation Pin: \$50.
- NCLEX-RN Exam and RN License Fees (includes related costs such as passport photos): ~\$450.

Total Estimate in Addition to Tuition

Approximately \$6,600.

Other Considerations

- The program requires travel to clinical facilities to complete assignments.
