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About the Program

The Dual Enrollment Teacher Career Academy is a one-year program designed for high school seniors interested in exploring a career in education and gaining foundational knowledge in teaching and learning.

The program includes coursework in education theory, child and adolescent development, classroom management, and instructional strategies. Students participate in hands-on experiences, including classroom observations and practicums, providing real-world insight into the teaching profession.

By the end of the program, students will have completed 24 college credits that can be applied toward a certificate, associate or bachelor's degree in education. The Teacher Academy also emphasizes leadership, communication, and professional ethics, preparing students for future success in teacher preparation programs and careers in education.
