# 6 STEPS TO QUICK START YOUR SVCC JOURNEY

## Connect and Explore Programs

Start your academic career at SVCC with the right information. Speak with one of our **Navigators** to learn which of SVCC's 60+ programs is the best fit for your career goals. New Student Navigators can also answer your questions about required documentation, placement testing, new student orientations, and course registration.

## Apply for Admissions

**Apply** online at [southside.edu/future-student](https://southside.edu/future-student). In order to provide a safe and secure learning environment, admission to our college requires that all new credit applicants verify their identity. Applicants will need access to a computer or mobile device that has a camera in order to provide a real-time photo of themselves (Liveness Check) and upload a photo ID (Driver's License, Passport, ID Card, etc.). Once you have completed your application you will receive your Student ID and username. **Save this information.** You will need both to log in to your MySVCC account.

**Log in to your MySVCC account** using your MySVCC credentials you received via email upon completion of your admissions application. For password reset or Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) assistance, visit <https://identity.my.vccs.edu/files/smsresetNew.html>, contact the SVCC Helpdesk through email at [helpdesk@southside.edu](mailto:helpdesk@southside.edu), or by calling 434-949-1010 Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM - 4:30 PM.

Log in to **Navigate** using your MySVCC username to help get a successful start and stay on track until you graduate. *Navigate is available 24 hours after the submission of your admissions application.*

## Apply for \$\$

Apply for financial aid and complete the online 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov). Use the **SVCC Federal School Code: 008661** (will appear as Alberta, VA location). Visit [southside.edu/financial-aid](https://southside.edu/financial-aid). **If you receive financial aid, apply each year.**

*PLEASE NOTE: For students and parents who are creating an FSA ID for the very first time, it is highly recommended to wait until the FSA ID has been verified BEFORE completing the actual FAFSA application. It can take 1-3 days for the account to be verified. This will make importing IRS tax information much easier for students and parents.*

Apply online for SVCC Foundation Scholarships. There is one common application to be considered for all available scholarships. Visit [southside.edu/scholarships](https://southside.edu/scholarships). If you are eligible for veteran education benefits, please visit [southside.edu/veterans-affairs](https://southside.edu/veterans-affairs).

### Navigate Your First Semester (Placement & Navigator Appointment)

Complete your **Direct Enrollment Survey** by logging in with your MySVCC username and password. This brief, 3-5 minute questionnaire will help determine your most appropriate English and math placement and first semester courses. (If you have already completed the Direct Enrollment Survey or other placement requirements, please move forward to the next admissions steps listed below.)

After completing placement requirements, schedule an appointment with a **Navigator** to assist you with your first course selections. Assistance is available in person, over the phone, or virtually.

*If you have previously attended colleges outside of the Virginia Community College System, submit official transcripts.*

### Get Advised

**New Students** – Prior to the start of the semester, your **Navigator or Student Services Professional** will help you with your academic and career goals. NOTE: You will be assigned a faculty advisor or Connect4Success Advisor who will assist you with future registrations.

**Returning Students** – After your first semester, your **Faculty Advisor or Connect4Success Advisor** will assist you with registering for classes. If you register early, you are more likely to get the classes you need and the schedule you want.

## 6

### Pay for Classes

After completing registration, your tuition bill will be available for viewing in your SIS Student Center through MySVCC.

Pay tuition and fees by the tuition due dates either in person with our Business Office or online via MySVCC. You can also apply for our Nelnet Tuition Payment Plan. **Your enrollment is not final until your tuition is paid.** For the most current tuition and payment due dates, visit [southside.edu/tuition-and-fees](https://southside.edu/tuition-and-fees).

*Success Tip — Ensure your application is received on time. FAFSAs are accepted all year but don't delay; it takes 3-5 business days to process.*

## **Degrees and Certificates**

### **Associate of Applied Science (AAS)**

SVCC's AAS degrees prepare students to enter the **workforce** upon completion. AAS degrees usually require 65-67 credits.

### **Associate of Arts & Sciences (AA&S)**

SVCC's Associate of Arts and Sciences (AA&S) degrees prepare students to transfer to 4-year colleges and universities. AA&S degrees usually require 60-63 credits.

### **Certificate (Cert)**

SVCC's Certificates (Cert) are intermediate credentials that help to prepare students to enter the **workforce** upon graduation and can be earned while also working towards an AAS or AA&S degree. Certificate Programs usually require 31-37 credits.

### **Career Studies Certificate (CSC)**


SVCC's Career Studies Certificates (CSC) usually require 16-28 credits. Like certificates, students can often meet the requirements of a career studies certificate while pursuing an AAS or AA&S degree.



### Navigate360

### Financial Aid

#### Financial Aid Process

[www.southside.edu/financial-aid](http://www.southside.edu/financial-aid)

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is generally available each year on October 1. SVCC aid year runs Fall, Spring, Summer. Students are strongly encouraged to apply between October and April. Plan ahead and complete your FAFSA as soon as possible. Once you have completed the online FAFSA, you will receive an email response from [FAFSA.gov](http://FAFSA.gov) listing your SAI. **This is NOT your actual college award.** The financial aid process may take up to eight weeks. Follow up with SVCC to ensure everything is completed. You may also log in to your MySVCC account to view your award status. Anticipated aid awards are based on ELIGIBLE courses. Courses not in your program cannot be covered by Financial Aid.

**You must apply annually.** FAFSAs are accepted all year; however, for priority, be sure your FAFSA is completed and submitted by:

- March 15 (summer semester)**
- June 30 (fall semester)**

Applications received after these dates will be processed in date order after all priority applications have been reviewed. *This means some funds may be limited, which could reduce the award you could have received. Filing in August could mean you may have to pay for tuition and books from personal funds while awaiting a reply from the Financial Aid Office regarding your financial aid eligibility.*

#### Financial Aid Class Eligibility (FACA)

To be financial aid eligible, the courses that you enroll in must count toward requirements in your program of study. If you are enrolled in ineligible courses, you will receive a message in your message center. You can check the FACA class status under the Financial Aid link in your Student Center.



#### When will I see this on my account?

If you have registered for classes, you will see this information within 24 hours.

#### What if I decide to pay out of pocket for a class?

To apply payment directly to the ineligible class, contact our cashier's office or off-campus center.

#### How do I find out what classes are ineligible?

Check your message center to see if you receive a message regarding your eligibility or check your class status in your **Student Center > Finances > View Financial Aid > Select Aid Year > Find your term and click View Course Eligibility.** You should see green check marks and not red x's. View the example below:

## Questions & Answers

### Q: How do I see my tuition bill?

**A:** Log in to **MySVCC** to access **Student Information Systems (SIS)**, then navigate to your Student Center. Scroll down to Finances. If the community college listed is NOT Southside, click **Select College** to change your preferences to Southside Virginia Community College. To ensure the proper balance is showing, click **Account Inquiry**. This action triggers a recalculation of tuition and fees.

### Q: When can I pay for my books with financial aid?

**A:** Financial aid recipients may charge books to their aid from December 27 – March 14 for spring 16-week classes. Bookstore charging with Financial Aid begins one week before classes begin through the last day to drop with a refund.

### Q: If I have a financial aid question, whom can I call?

**A:** Please call (434) 949-1094 or visit your Student Center in the Student Information System (SIS).



## NAVIGATE YOUR FIRST SEMESTER

(Placement & Navigate Appointment)

New Student Navigators help students get placed in their desired programs and the most appropriate levels of English and math based on their writing, reading, and math abilities. Appropriate placement is determined by completion of the Direct Enrollment Survey and/or transcript evaluation of prior English and/or mathematics college-level coursework.

Students should complete the questionnaire for placement using this link: <https://desurvey.vccs.edu/login>. You will login to the survey by using your MySVCC username and password. If you do not have this information, please contact the SVCC IT Helpdesk at 434-949-1010 or [helpdesk@southside.edu](mailto:helpdesk@southside.edu).

In some special cases, such as students using military benefits, students may need to complete the Virginia Placement Test (VPT) to help determine their English and math placement. For more information, please speak with your College Navigator.

### Transfer of Prior Coursework

Students can submit official transcripts to the Admissions Office showing completion of college-level English or math with a grade of C or higher at an accredited institution where English is the official language. ### Payment Dates

**Tuition payments are due based on your date of registration.** Payments can be received in person or over the phone by 4 PM or prior to midnight if paying through **MySVCC**. If using the Nelnet Payment Plan, the transaction must be successfully completed prior to midnight on your tuition due date.

### Tuition Payment Plan

To help meet students' educational expenses, SVCC is offering the Tuition Payment Plan for each semester through Nelnet Campus Commerce & Nelnet Payment Plan. For a non-refundable term fee of \$30.00, Nelnet allows you to pay your tuition in monthly payments. You can make payments automatically from a checking or savings account or by credit card. To sign up, select **Apply for Payment Plan**, which is found on the **My Student Information** tile of your **Student Information System (SIS)**.





# The Student Center in SIS

The Student Center provides you with an overview of your official student records. Each section provides you with important details about your account to ensure that you make appropriate decisions. You can check for communications, your unofficial transcripts, print your class schedule, pay your tuition, check your financial aid, update your address and phone, check your To Do List, check your holds, and get information about your advisor.

1. **Message Center:** Official communication from the college will be sent to your message center. Be sure to check your unread messages as this may contain important information to keep you successful. *Tip: Any communication regarding your Financial Aid class eligibility will only come in this inbox.*
2. **Academics:** Use the **Academics** section to search for classes, enroll and drop classes, print your class schedule, check your *My Academics* (advising reports and student planner), print a copy of your unofficial transcripts, check your official grades and run a what-if analysis. *Tip: You will need your class schedule and your student id to purchase books.*
3. **Finances — Select College:** The college name listed shows your user default. If the college name is something other than Southside, then you may have issues paying for college online. Click the Select College to correct the college to make payments.
4. **Finances — My Account:** Use the *My Account* link to check your summary, activity, charges due, payments, and pending aid.
5. **Finances — Financial Aid:** Use the link to verify your financial aid awards. After you submit your FAFSA, it takes 3-5 business days for our college to receive the data. Eligibility is determined and aid posted on your account. You will use this link to determine which classes are considered eligible for financial aid awards.
6. **Finances — Make a Payment, Apply for Payment Plan, Manage Refunds:** Use this link to make online payment, apply for payment plan and manage refunds.
7. **Personal Information — Emergency Contact:** Please make sure to update your emergency contact.
8. **Personal Information — Mailing Address and Phone:** Please verify your address and phone and make any necessary changes. It is important to keep this information up to date.
9. **Holds:** Check your account to ensure that there are no issues with your account. Holds could prevent you from enrolling in classes, receiving your transcripts and/or diploma. **To Do List:** Check your account to see if you have any outstanding checklists for financial aid or admissions.
10. **Advisor:** Verify that you know your current advisor. He or she can help you decide on classes in the future.

## Withdrawal

After the drop period, you can remove a course from your schedule and receive a grade of "W" if you withdraw by the last day to withdraw without academic penalty. A "W" will not negatively impact your GPA but could impact your financial aid. *Before removing any course, please speak with Student Services or your academic advisor and Financial Aid to explore all options.*

## Late Starting Courses

Courses that begin after the start of the regular 16-week semester. These classes are usually offered in 12-, 10-, or 2<sup>nd</sup> 8-week formats.



## FERPA

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records.

## Drop/Add Period

The drop/add period is at the beginning of each semester/term. You are able to delete classes without penalty and/or add classes to ensure the best schedule for your semester. *See the Academic Calendar on page 2 for specific dates.*

## ZOOM

Live interactive video-streaming that broadcasts class sessions at multiple locations.  
**SYNCHRONOUS** — Zoom to home  
**ASYNCHRONOUS** — No set meeting time

## Seated Courses

Courses taught on campus or at one of our off-campus locations.

## Hybrid Courses

Courses taught in a partially-seated/partially-online format.

## Online Courses

Courses taught through the online platform Canvas. *It's important to log in to your online courses as soon as the courses start.*

## OER/OER Courses

“Open Educational Resource” courses use an online textbook, which is often free or minimally expensive.

## Academic Progress Report

An unofficial copy of your academic record that also details the required courses remaining for your certificate or degree completion. This report can be accessed in your MySVCC.

## Transcript

An official copy of your permanent academic record that includes courses taken, dates of attendance, major, type of credential awarded, cumulative grade point average (GPA), and all honors received.

## Meeting SAP

In order to receive financial aid, a student must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress. The Financial Aid Office evaluates students for grade point average, completion rate, and maximum time. *Please visit [southside.edu/financial-aid](https://southside.edu/financial-aid) for more information.*

## Syllabus

A document that states what the course is, what you’ll learn, the professor’s policies, and often, the sequence of assignments. *Every class syllabus is different; please review your syllabus for each class at the beginning of the semester.*

## SIS/Student Information System

An online tool that provides an overview of your official student record.

## Student Email

Your official college email that is accessible through MySVCC after you are fully enrolled. All emailed communication from the college will be sent to your SVCC student email.

## Navigate

An online platform assisting students with exploring their academic paths while also navigating through the academic journey with success.

## Graduation Application

A document completed by you and your advisor certifying that you have completed your program of study’s course requirements. A graduation application must be submitted for each credential you complete.

## Domicile

A classification determining a student’s eligibility for in-state or out-of-state tuition rates based on the student’s residency or residency of the student’s parent(s) for one year prior to admission and intent to remain within the state.


